



WOMEN'S MARCH

On Saturday, January 21st, 2017 in the United States, after Donald Trump first speech as the president of the US, millions of women participated in "Women's march" The Pussy Hats, wearing pink hats with cat ears, have become the symbol of the opposition to Donald Trump, as women protest against the billionaire taking office and fight for the women's rights.

People of all sexes, ages, races, cultures and political leanings demonstrated in 400 American cities and 70 countries on that day to protest against his disturbing intentions concerning minorities, the access to the contraception and the defense of family planning, environmental protection and the welcoming of the refugees.

Later that day, Donald Trump provoked the demonstrators' on Twitter, saying that those who paraded against him had not gone to vote in the presidential election of November 8th.

NATURE, NEW ELDORADO OF FINANCE ?

Climate change has redefined nature. TRUMP'S DECREE

The American president Donald Trump signed a decree hardening border control in the United States. With this decree, the American authorities can suspend nationals' and refugees' arrival from seven Muslim countries: Iraq, Iran, Libya, Somalia, Sudan, Syria and Yemen.

The measure aroused indignation in the Middle East, in North Africa and in Europe. It also created confusion and sometimes panic among travelers heading to the United States, some of whom had to turn back.

This decree, supposedly signed "to protect the nation against the entrance of terrorists foreign to the United States" caused indignant reactions worldwide and is already the object of a complaint filed by several American civil rights associations, among which the powerful ACLU, who wants it repealed.
